

## EXAMPLE NANNY JOB DESCRIPTION

### Looking for live-in nanny for 20+ hours a week, including some overnights

Single mom in New Haven is looking for a nonsmoking, live-in nanny to work 20+ hours per week, helping care for a 4-year-old boy and helping manage the household. Child is in daycare (Mon - Fri, 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.), and a live-in is needed to build a strong bond and keep a consistent routine when mom travels overnight for business (on average 2-4 nights a month).

The nanny will need to have a car, driver's license, auto insurance and a clean driving record. You may have a second job and/or take college classes when child is at daycare on weekdays, as long as you are available if there is an emergency or the child becomes ill and must go home.

In exchange for child care (including daycare pickup/drop-off, sick days, driving to karate and swim class 3 days a week) and household management (light cooking, laundry, cleaning), the nanny will get a furnished, private bedroom and bath with all utilities, plus an hourly rate of \$25 per hour, as well as two week's paid vacation.

The nanny must pass a background check, have current CPR and first aid, some college and/or a child care or nanny certification, at least 3 years' nanny experience and at least three references. The ideal nanny will be looking to join our household long term with a minimum, one-year commitment, starting October 1. For those who like pets, we have a cat.
